Bonaire “Power Up” Progress The Bonaire Transmitter Power Upgrade

We continue to celebrate God’s provision as Cubans await a more powerful signal from TWR’s AM radio station on the island of Bonaire. Of the \$3.8 million we set out to raise, we have \$1.5 million to go! That’s 60 percent of our goal reached, and we are so grateful for your prayers and support. Your participation in Bonaire Power Up will help us to reach more listeners like Esneider and Liset. Here’s what they wrote to us recently about the Spanish broadcasts reaching into Cuba:

From Esneider: “Greetings, TWR, and may God bless you very much. You are a great seasoned group that works collectively to extend the kingdom of the Lord and the gospel message to all nations. Every time I listen to you - albeit with difficulty because sometimes the signal here in Cuba is not good - I like the way you teach the word clearly for all your listeners. I really like the program *Messages of Faith and Hope*. Receive a greeting from one of your listeners.”

From Liset: “Brothers, May God bless you immensely. I’m so glad that you have not forgotten about me. Your words are a blessing and the Word of God through you. Continue praying that in Cuba we would be able to hear the Word on more radio and television media. I hear you better at night on my radio, but I don’t know how many more people in the country can hear you. Your sister in Christ loves you.”

In addition to about 25 existing Spanish programs already on the air, the staff of TWR Cuba are working on three more that will minister specifically to Cubans:

Basic Theological Training to provide house church pastors with theological training.

Leadership in Worship to provide a biblical understanding of worship with practical applications.

Christian Living in the Cuban Context to answer questions about spiritual, physical, and emotional health while living in a communist country.
